Ed Gallo Escondido City Councilman

Born and raised in New Jersey, Ed Gallo attended Rutgers University after graduating from Bound Brook High School in Bound Brook, New Jersey. Then shortly after the assassination of President John F. Kennedy in November 1963, Ed enlisted in the US Army spending time at Ft. Bragg, North Carolina and taking classes at North Carolina State. He then did a tour of duty in South Korea -serving in G-2 alongside KATUSA (Korean Augmentation to the U S Army). After returning to the states from South Korea, he went to Ft. Bliss, Texas to complete three years of 'a great opportunity'. Later he returned to New Jersey and was re-employed in the supermarket industry and once again attended Rutgers, and became a store manager the next year. After having enough of the East Coast weather, he moved his family to Escondido in 1973 and plans to be here 'for the duration'. After a few years of running stores in San Diego County, Ed got his real estate license and has enjoyed the ups and downs, 'feast and famine' of the industry and has gained many learning experiences.

Ed's civic involvement began in 1974 when he joined the Escondido Jaycees and worked on various Jaycee projects which required interaction with the City of Escondido. He has chaired 5 Jaycee parades including the Centennial. He is a Past President and recipient of the U.S. Jaycees Ambassador Award, the only such recognition in the Escondido's Jaycees 63-year history. Other City activities include serving on the Escondido Centennial Steering Committee, Bravo Escondido, the opening of California Center for the Arts, Escondido (CCAE), the Downtown Revitalization Committee beginning in 1990, the Transportation Commission, the Planning Commission and was then elected to the Escondido City Council for the first time in 2000. Ed is currently serving his third term as an elected official in Escondido and was recently appointed to serve on the San Diego County Water Authority.
