October 21st Program Ken Gosselin Candidate for San Diego County Superior Court Judge



Ken Gosselin has a proven judicial record for both fairness and for aggressive enforcement of the law to protect our citizens. He is the most experienced Superior Court Judge Pro Tem in San Diego County history and he has presided over thousands of Criminal, Civil and Juvenile court cases in nearly eight years of full time volunteer judicial service. Ken received his legal education from the University Of Laverne College Of Law and from Harvard Law School. Prior to becoming a lawyer, Ken was employed by the FBI, the Riverside County DA's Office, and for nearly a decade he was a single parent of his physically disabled, autistic son. As a lawyer, Ken devoted his law practice to real estate litigation and he worked as special counsel in cases related to Vatican-owned real estate. Ken is an alumnus of the Oliver Wendell Holmes, Jr. College of Trial Advocacy, the Welsh College of Trial Advocacy, and in 2008 he was as appointed Special Master by the San Diego County Superior Court.
