May 19th Program Dr. Greg Quist



President of the Rincon del Diablo Water Board

Currently the President of the Rincon del Diablo Mutual Water District Board of Directors, Greg Quist has served on the Board continuously in a variety of capacities – including Treasurer, Vice President - since being elected to the Board in 1990. Between 1996 and 2008 Greg served as Rincon's representative to the San Diego County Water Authority (SDCWA) and has been active in the Association of California Water Agencies (ACWA), serving on the Water Quality Committee as Vice Chair of the Safe Drinking Water Subcommittee and currently on the Groundwater Committee. Greg was elected by Orange and San Diego County ACWA members as Chair of Region 10 and subsequently served on the ACWA Board of Directors. Greg helped found and chaired the Economic Study Group, a group of nine North San Diego County water agencies, that was successful in gaining water rate savings of nearly \$2 million per year from the SDCWA. Greg has founded a series of high technology start-up companies, most recently co-founding Escondido-based Hadronex nine years ago with his business partner, David Drake. Hadronex designs, manufactures and sells wireless telemetry and sensing systems to utilities and commercial businesses in the USA and around the world.
