District 4 includes a huge stretch of North County and East County school districts – stretching from Vista to the eastern county line and from Lakeside to the northern boundary – including Alpine and Borrego Springs school districts.

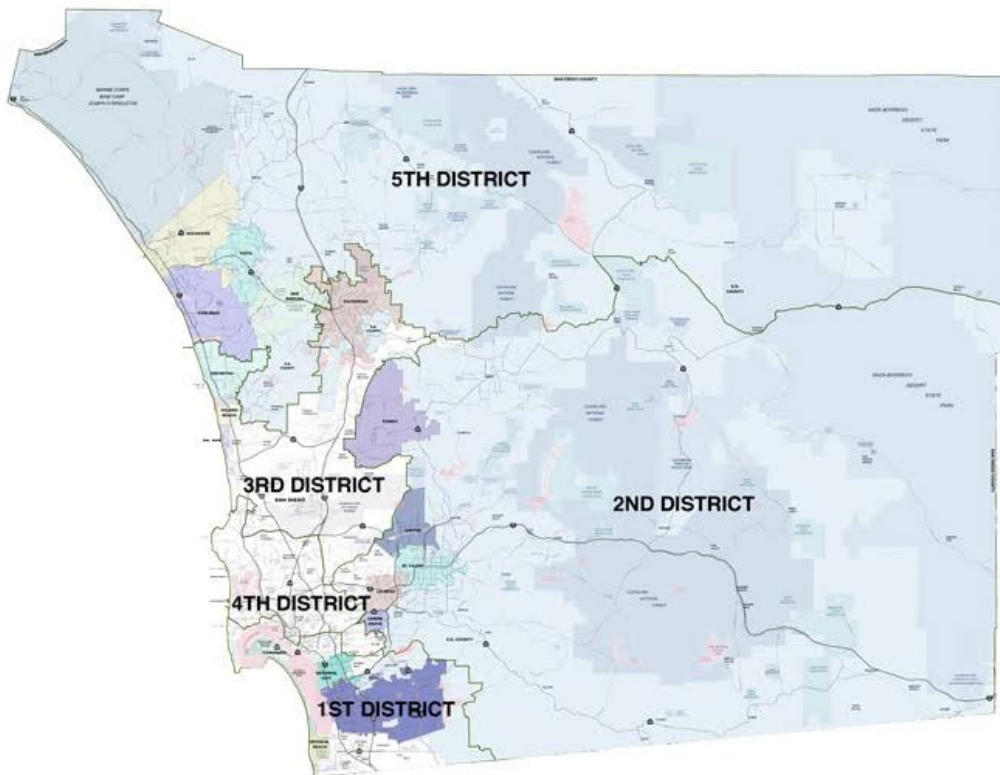
