Kristin Gaspar, candidate for San Diego County Supervisor – District #3, is a successful small businesswoman, Mayor of Encinitas, and active mother. Kristin is challenging the current District #3 San Diego County Supervisor, Dave Roberts, in the General Election on November 8, 2016.

In 2002, Kristin and her husband, Paul, took a chance and grew their own small business. It wasn't easy, and they spent many nights going over the books to make sure they could keep the doors open, and eventually grow and create more jobs. Their hard work and perseverance paid off – and Kristin rose to Chief Financial Officer of the six offices of 'Gaspar Doctors of Physical Therapy', which employees nearly 100 people.

As Kristin's business grew, so did her family, and she felt it was time to play a more active role in her community to ensure that her children inherited the same quality of life she benefitted from growing up in North County. As a young mother, she decided to run for the Encinitas City Council. She won, running on a platform of fiscal responsibility and stressing the need to get back to the basics of enhancing public safety, protecting our environment, improving streets and neighborhoods. In 2014 she ran to be the first elected Mayor of Encinitas, and was elected.
