Known for traveling the world to gain insight on important stories, Mark has covered the Iraq war on location in the Middle East, smuggled Bibles to the underground church in Southeast Asia and done ground-breaking broadcasts from war zones including the Persian Gulf region and Afghanistan. He has also visited Russia and made several trips to China, including Tibet.
